




[20x40, viewed from A end]

* All steps score the same


* (1) Transitions into and out of medium strides are part of this movement




A: Enter in working trot and proceed down centre line without halting
C: Turn left




E: Circle left 20 metres
K: Half circle left 10 metres to D and proceed to H




B: Circle right 20 metres in diameter
F: Half circle right 10 metres to D and proceed to M




C: Medium walk
HX: Change rein in medium walk




XFK: Free walk on long rein
K: Medium walk



E: Working trot



bet. H&C: Working canter right
Between C and F
Show some medium canter strides (1)
F: Working canter



A: Half circle right 20 metres
Over X: Transition through trot to working canter left and half circle left 20 metres to C






CK: Show some medium canter strides (1)
K: Working canter




A: Half circle left 20 metres

canter right and half circle right 20 metres
to C




C: Working trot
MXK: Change the rein and show some medium trot strides (1)




KAF: Working trot
FXH: Change the rein and show some medium trot strides (1)



B: Circle right 20 metres and allow the horse to stretch and before returning to B retake reins.



- BA: Working trot
- A: Down centre line
- D: Medium walk



X: Halt immobility salute
Leave the arena in a free walk on a long rein where appropriate
